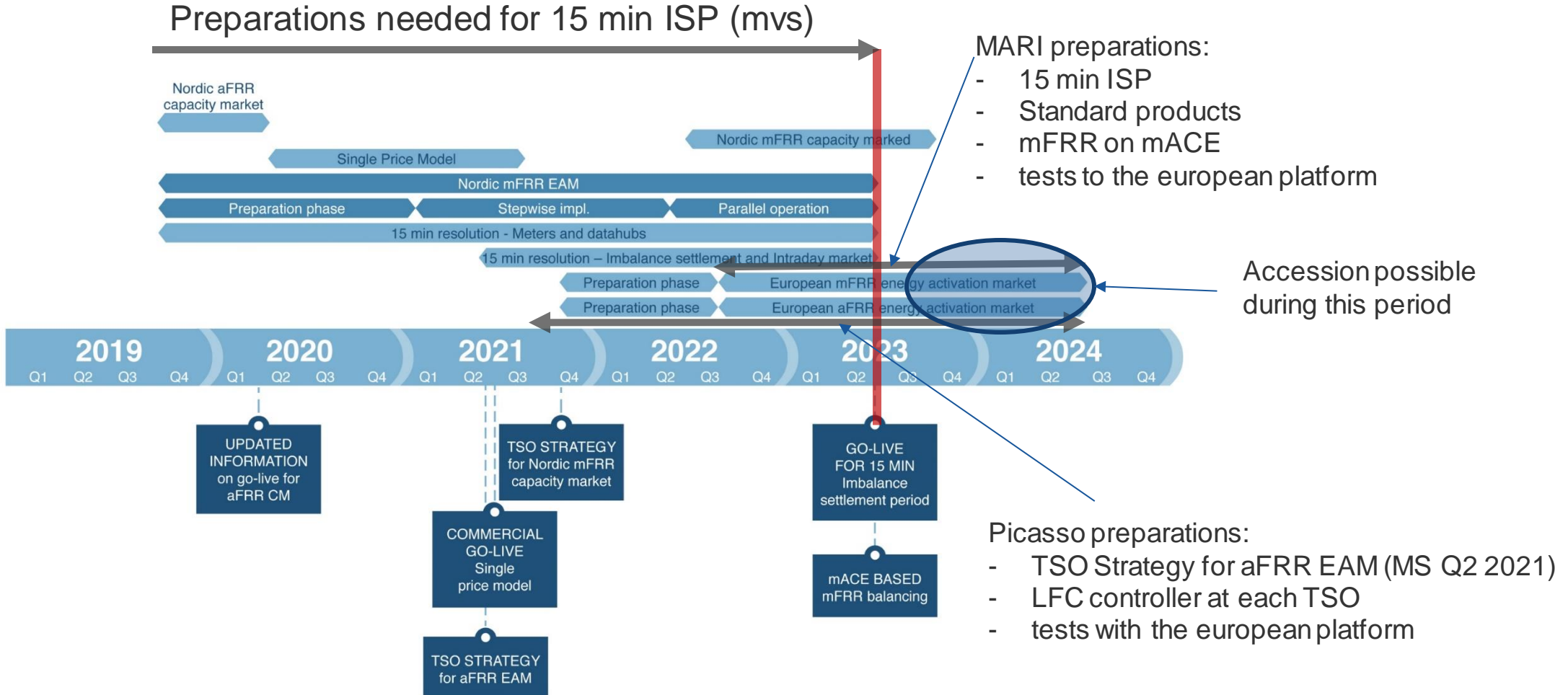

Background

- The Nordic TSOs need to deliver input to MARI and Picasso accession plans clarifying if there is need for derogation and the plan for accessing the platforms. No exact date needed at this point.
 - The accession plans will be published by ENTSO-E April 24
- Input from the Nordic TSOs is aligned and according to NBM roadmap
 - It is not possible for the Nordic TSOs to join the platforms according to the European plan
 - The Nordic TSOs need to seek derogation for both MARI and Picasso.
 - Accession is possible during Q3 2023 – Q2 2024, which is according to NBM roadmap and what has been communicated to stakeholders
 - Nordic NRAs have been, or will be informed about the process

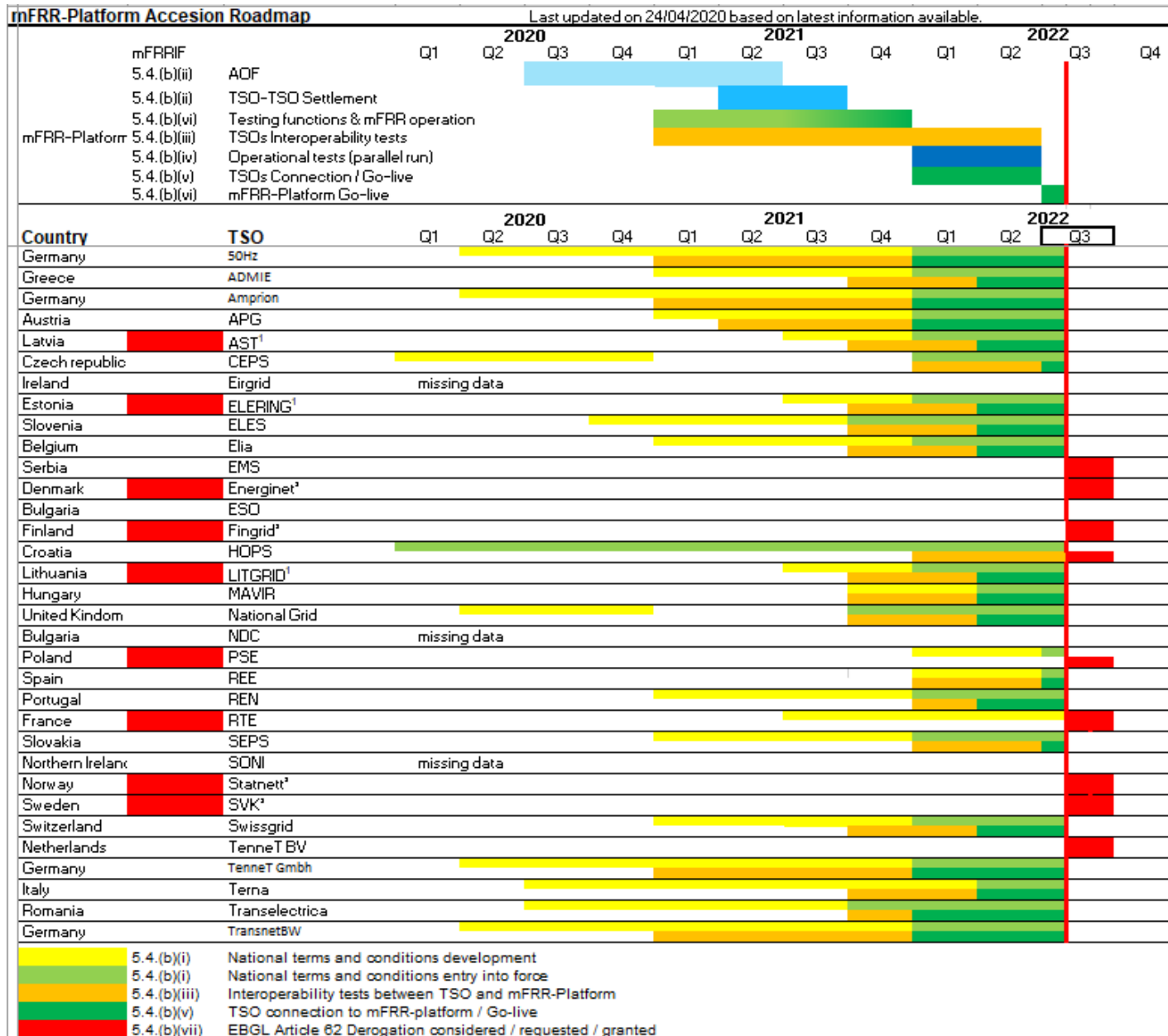
NBM roadmap and possible accession



Next steps

- NBM starts up activities on
 - Plan to access MARI
 - Plan to access Picasso, including TSO strategy on aFRR EAM
- The Nordic TSOs will have to request a derogation from EB GL article 20.5 and 21.5
 - EB GL article 62.4 Derogations:
 - TSOs shall file a written request for derogation to the relevant regulatory authority at the latest six months prior to the day of application of the provisions from which the derogation is requested.
 - Request for derogation needs to be filed before end of Q4 2021

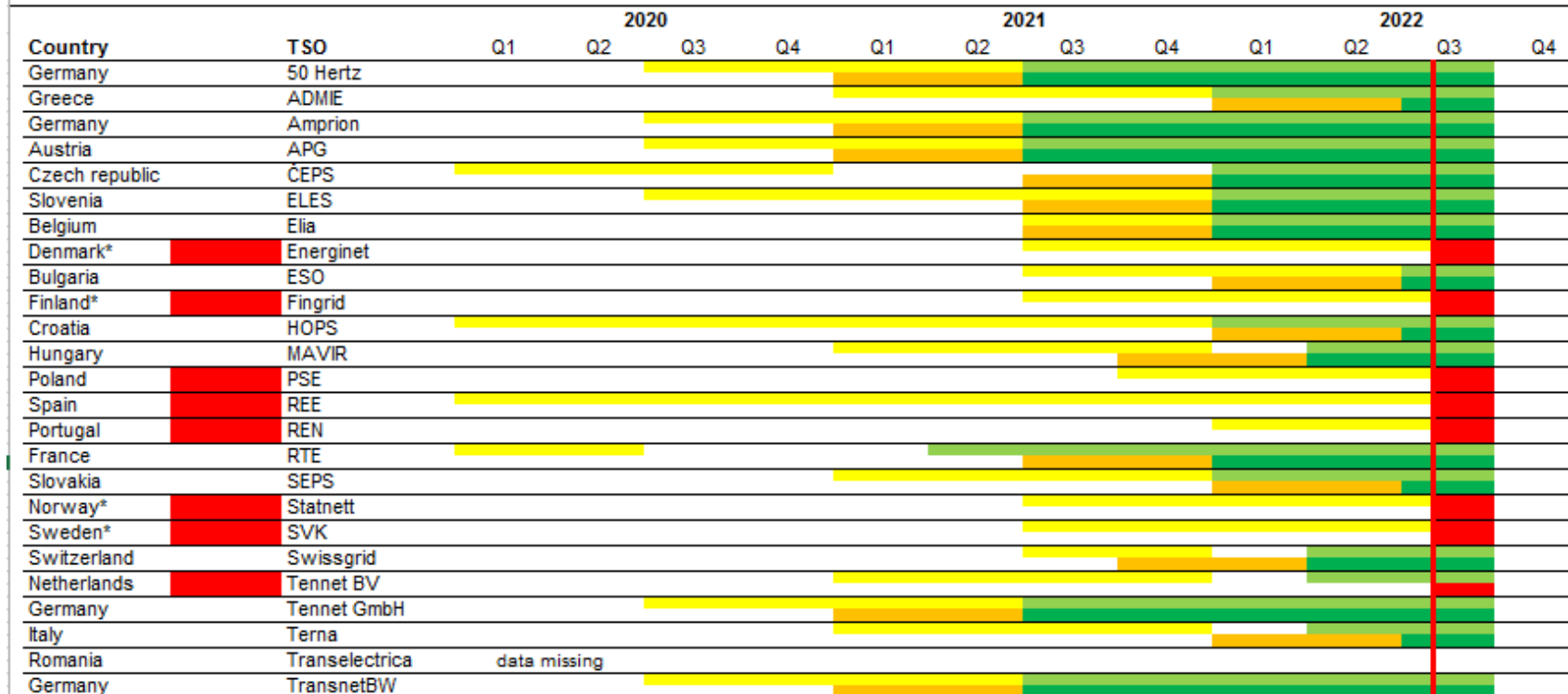
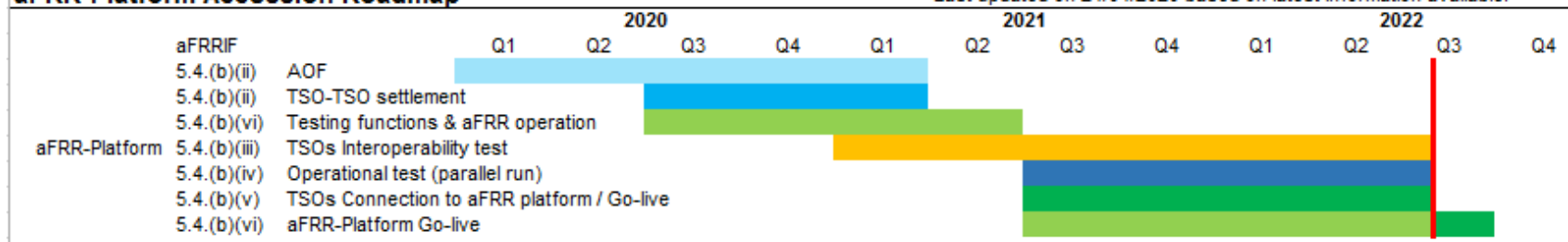

¹ - Baltic TSOs connection time to the mFRR-platform is conditional on the neighbouring TSOs – Baltic TSOs aim not to operate Baltic mFRR market inefficiently in the decoupled mode from the other areas on the mFRR-platform. Feasible time for joining will be analysed by Baltic TSOs.
